

Important Additional Stroke and Match Play Information

- Valid and up to date handicaps are required. Scores from all games must be posted to the Golf Canada Score Center prior to each match play game played. Failure to play with an invalid handicap will result in disqualification.
- The Handicap Allowance Table as per the World Handicap System is in effect and to be applied in conjunction with the Stroke Index Allocations listed on the scorecard (Handicap holes list) to determine allocation of strokes.
- Tee Box Selection: Course Handicaps and handicap allowances are determined by tees played.

Women's Stroke and Match Play Competition -Play is from the RED TEE box only.

Men's Stroke and Match Play - Tee box selection is stipulated by event.

Mixed Match Play – Women play from the RED TEES, Men play from the WHITE TEES.

- First match pairings are determined by a blind draw.
- Initial honours for Match Play (who tees off first on the first tee) are determined by player or team listed on the top of the bracket for that event.
- Ties will be broken by a sudden death play-off starting at the 1st tee, using the same Handicap Allowances and allocation of strokes.
- In the event of inclement weather, all parties must agree to cease play at the end of the current hole. In the event of thunderstorm activity, all parties MUST cease play.
- Resuming Play – new tee time to be booked that is acceptable to all players. Resume match play at the hole where play was ceased. (since you will start at the 1st tee, it is suggested that non-competitive stroke play is used until you reach the hole where the match ceased.) *We recognize that this remedy does not follow the Rules of Golf.*
